K- 12 Challenge This category encourages Vermont K-12 public and private schools to compete for the top performing school. It is easy to participate – go to www.waytogovt.org and click *Business Sign Up* to complete registration for your school. Designate a single contact person and begin promoting Way to Go! to students, faculty and staff. All they need to do is click *Sign Up!* at www.waytogovt.org and then select their school name on the registration page.

The Way to Go! Green Team will keep track of the competing communities and schools and award the top performers based on their participation rates. Be creative and identify every opportunity to engage residents and students on ways to promote alternative transportation, including local/school events. Establish a sign-up and information table at community events to encourage these alternatives.
